#### ORDER

1. During the Hearing dated 26.07.2016 on the Petition for approval of Business Plan for the control period of 2016-19 submitted by APGCL, the representative of APGCL made a brief presentation on the submitted Business Plan, along with details about various revisions/clarification submitted vide various correspondences. APGCL representative mentioned that APGCL Board has accorded approval to the submitted Business Plan and the extract of Board resolution have been submitted to the Commission vide Letter dated 20.07.2016.
2. The representative of the Petitioner (APGCL) further submitted that after approval of the Business Plan, some time will be required for filling the MYT Tariff petition for 2016-19, which may eventually be nearer to the timeline for submission for Tariff petition for FY 2017-18. Therefore, APGCL prayed that along with the MYT petition, the Tariff Petition for FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18 may be allowed to be filed.

Commission accepted the prayer of APGCL for filing of Tariff Petition for FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18 together, however, directed that along with the MYT Petition APGCL has to file true up for FY 2014-15, and FY 2015-16 along with the unaudited statements of 6 months expenditure & revenue for FY 2016-17.

3. The Commission enquired from APGCL whether it is possible to achieve Power for All (PFA) initiative by GOA and GOI by the capital investment which they have proposed in the Business Plan for 2016-19. APGCL replied that, considering the present scenario they have proposed a feasible capital Investment plan in the Business plan for 2016-19, which differ in certain areas from the PFA document.

The Commission reserved the order on Petition for approval of Business Plan for the control period of 2016-19 submitted by APGCL and stated that order will be issued in due course of time.
